





Job Trends

From 2014 to 2019, jobs **increased by 2.3**% in North-central Iowa: Heartland Power Service Territory (Cerro Gordo, Chickasaw, Floyd, Hancock, Howard, Kossuth, Mitchell, Winnebago & Worth Counties) (Report provided courtesy of the 7 Rivers Alliance) from 71,969 to **73,591**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 7.9% by 5.6**%.













Top Occupation Earnings


2019 Median Hourly Earnings








