



Job Trends


From 2014 to 2019, jobs **increased by 2.0%** in Prosperity Southwest WI: Richland Electric & Scenic Rivers Energy Service Territories (Crawford, Grant, Green, Iowa, Lafayette & Richland Counties) (Report courtesy of the 7 Rivers Alliance) from 69,606 to **71,027**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 7.9% by 5.9%**.




Unemployment Rate Trends



Your area has 26,479 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 33,425.




Retiring Soon


Racial Diversity










Top Industry LQ






Top Industry GRP















Top Occupation Earnings


2019 Median Hourly Earnings








