Jobs **grew by 1,421** over the last 5 years and are projected to **grow by 2,402** over the next 5 years.

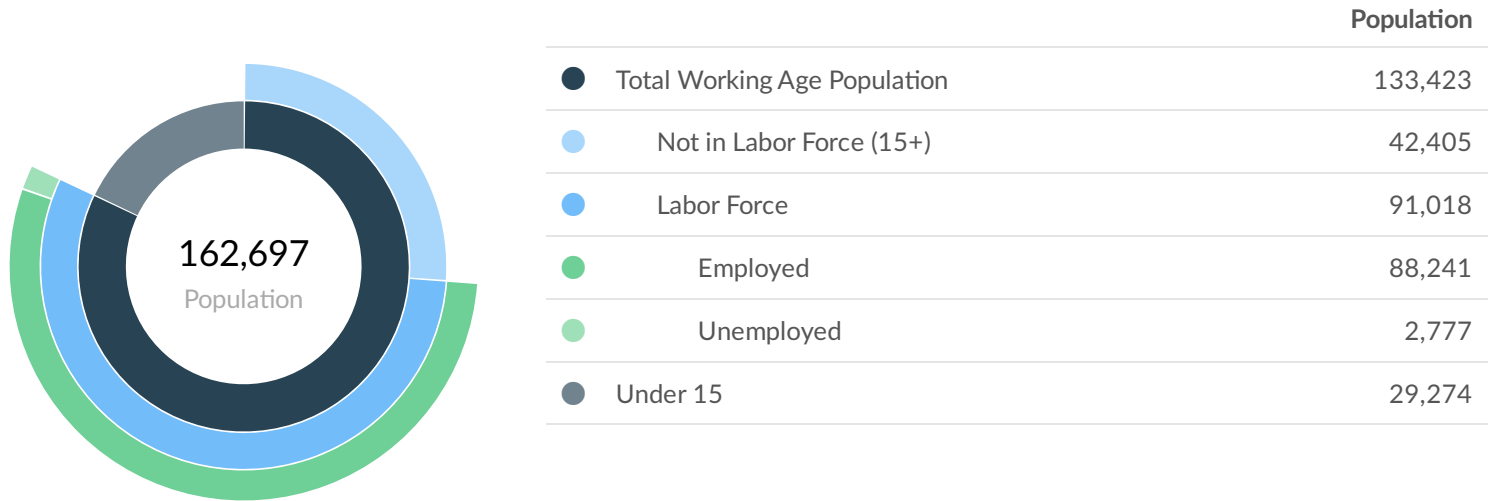

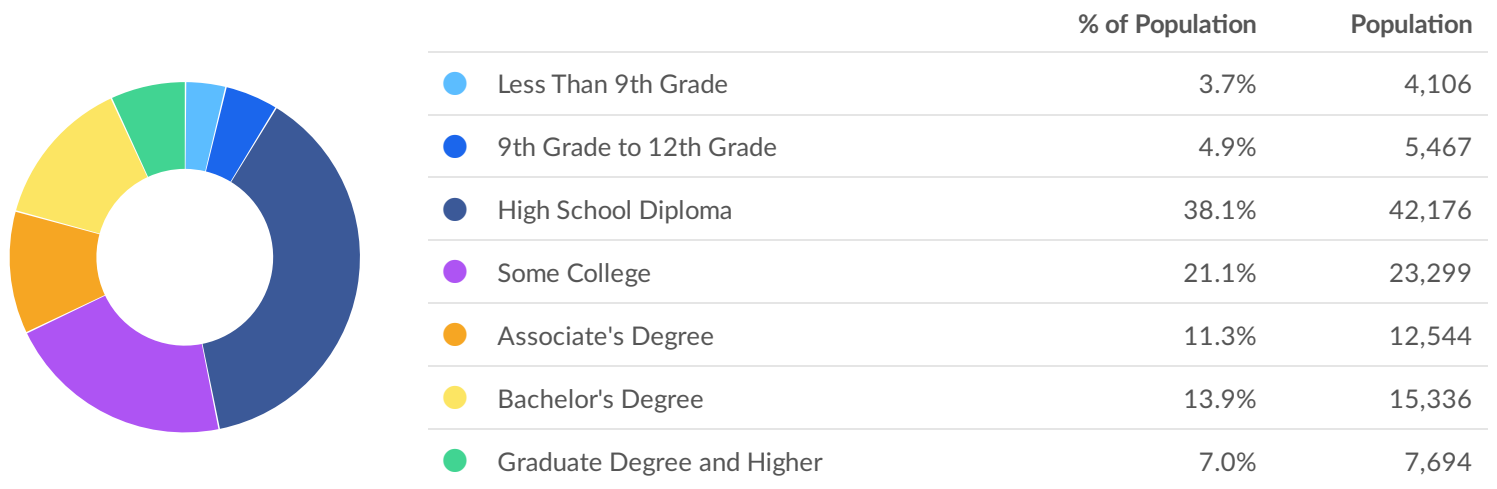

Educational Attainment

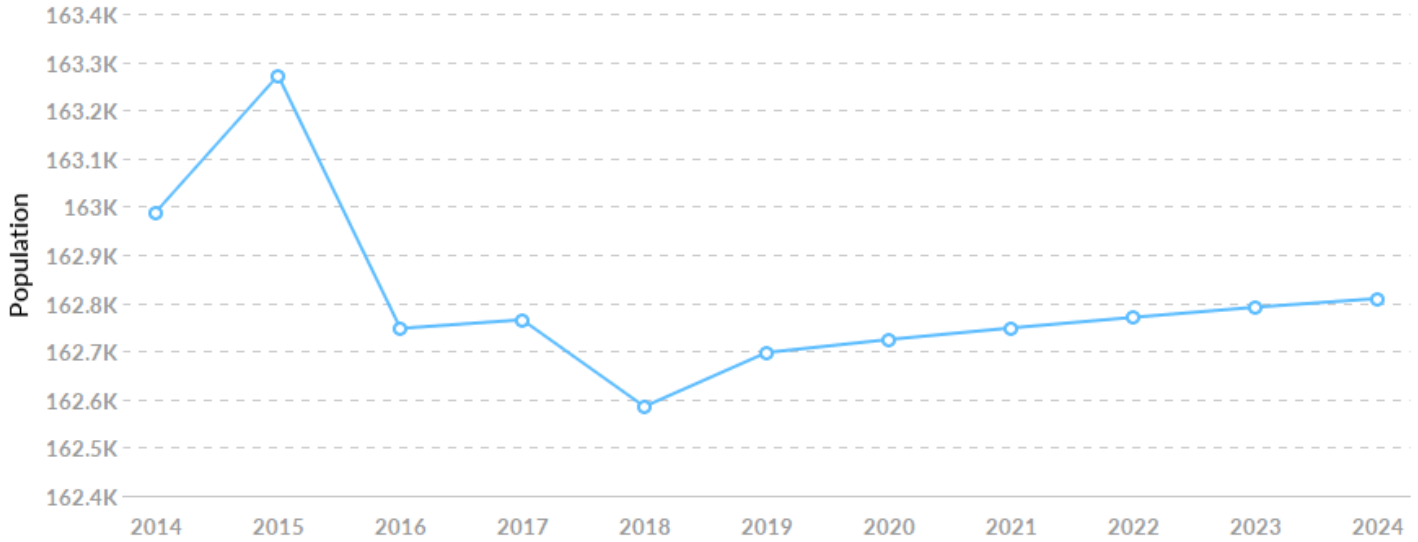

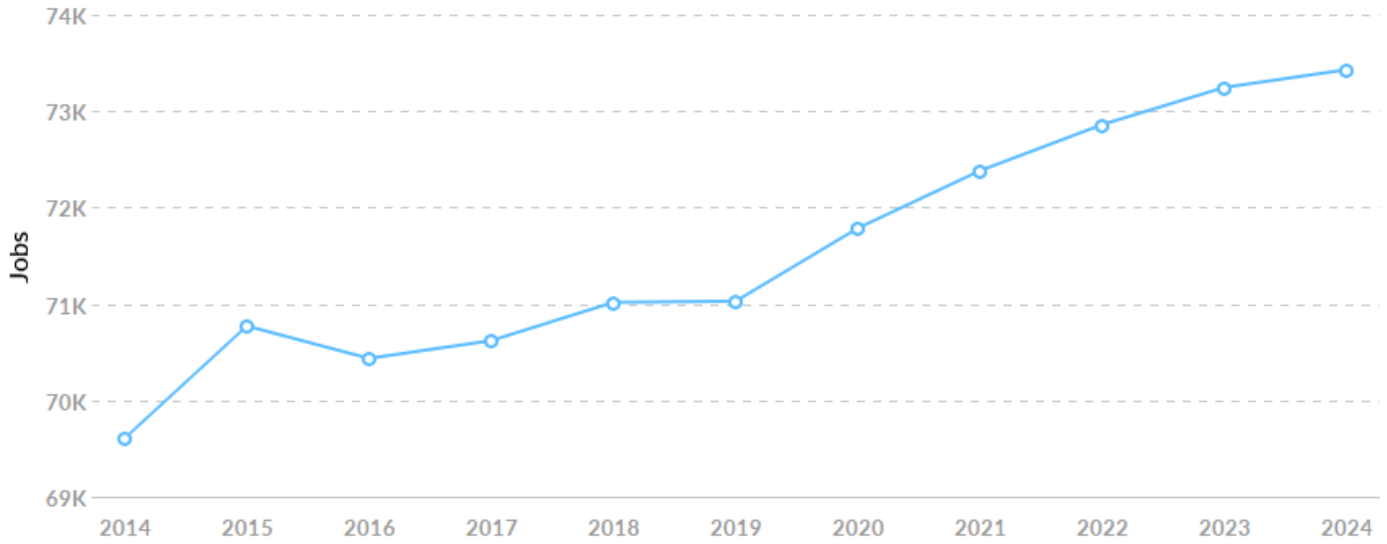

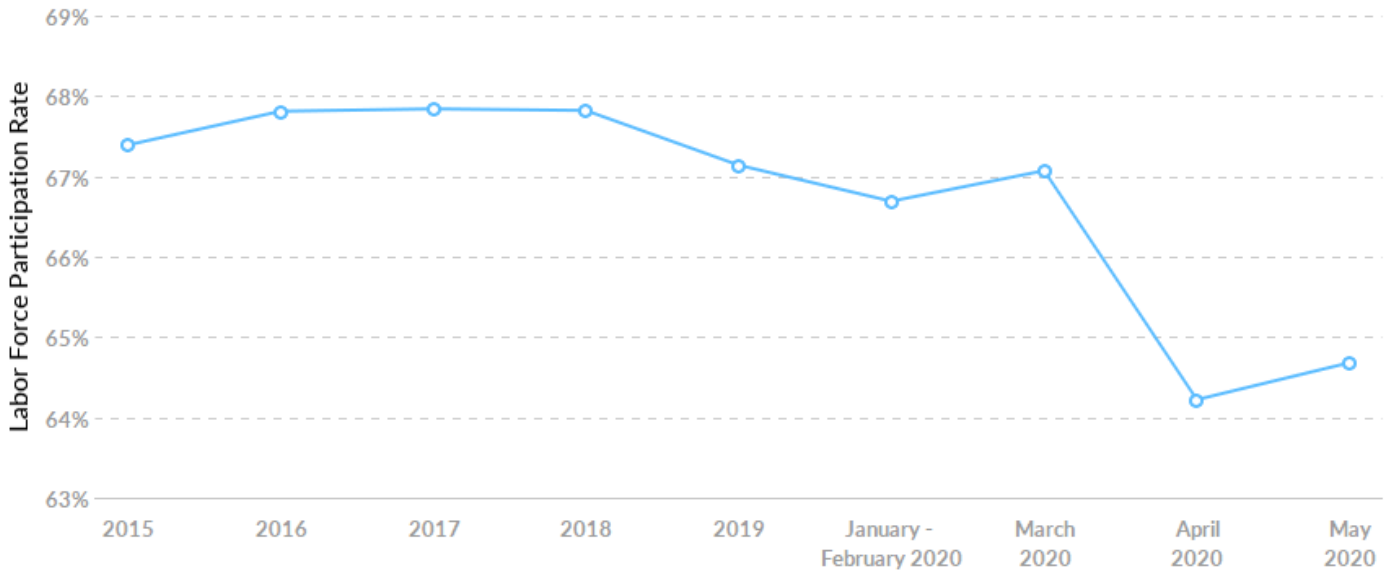
Job Trends

From 2014 to 2019, jobs increased by 2.0% in Prosperity Southwest WI: Richland Electric & Scenic Rivers Energy Service Territories (Crawford, Grant, Green, Iowa, Lafayette & Richland Counties) (Report courtesy of the 7 Rivers Alliance) from 69,606 to 71,027. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 7.9% by 5.9%.

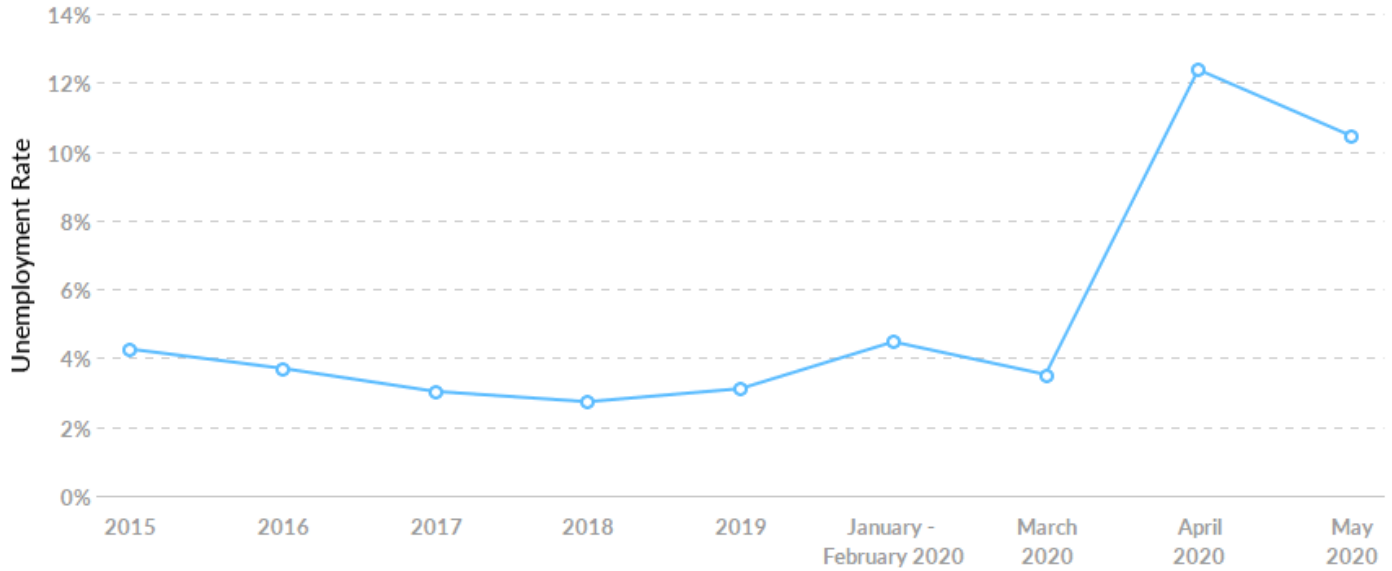

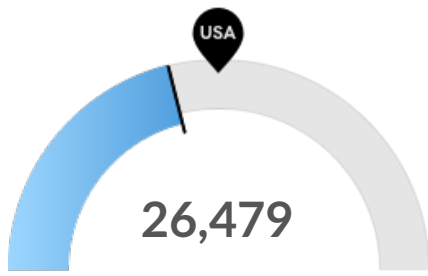

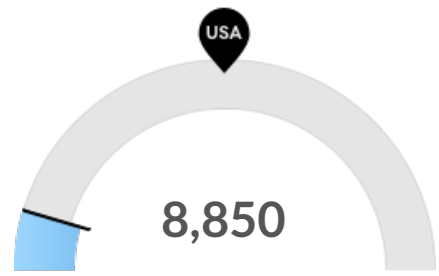
Millennials

Your area has 26,479 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 33,425.



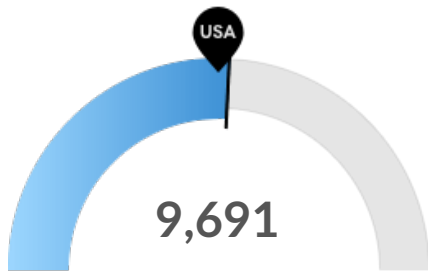
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in your area. The national average for an area this size is 47,063 people 55 or older, while there are 55,477 here.



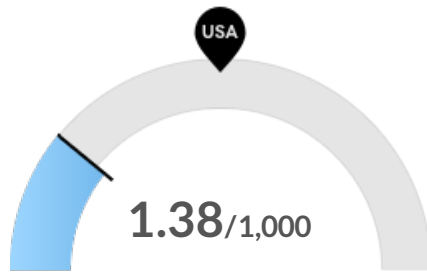
Racial Diversity

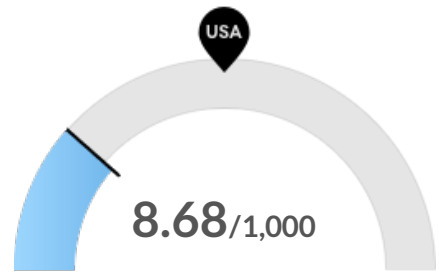

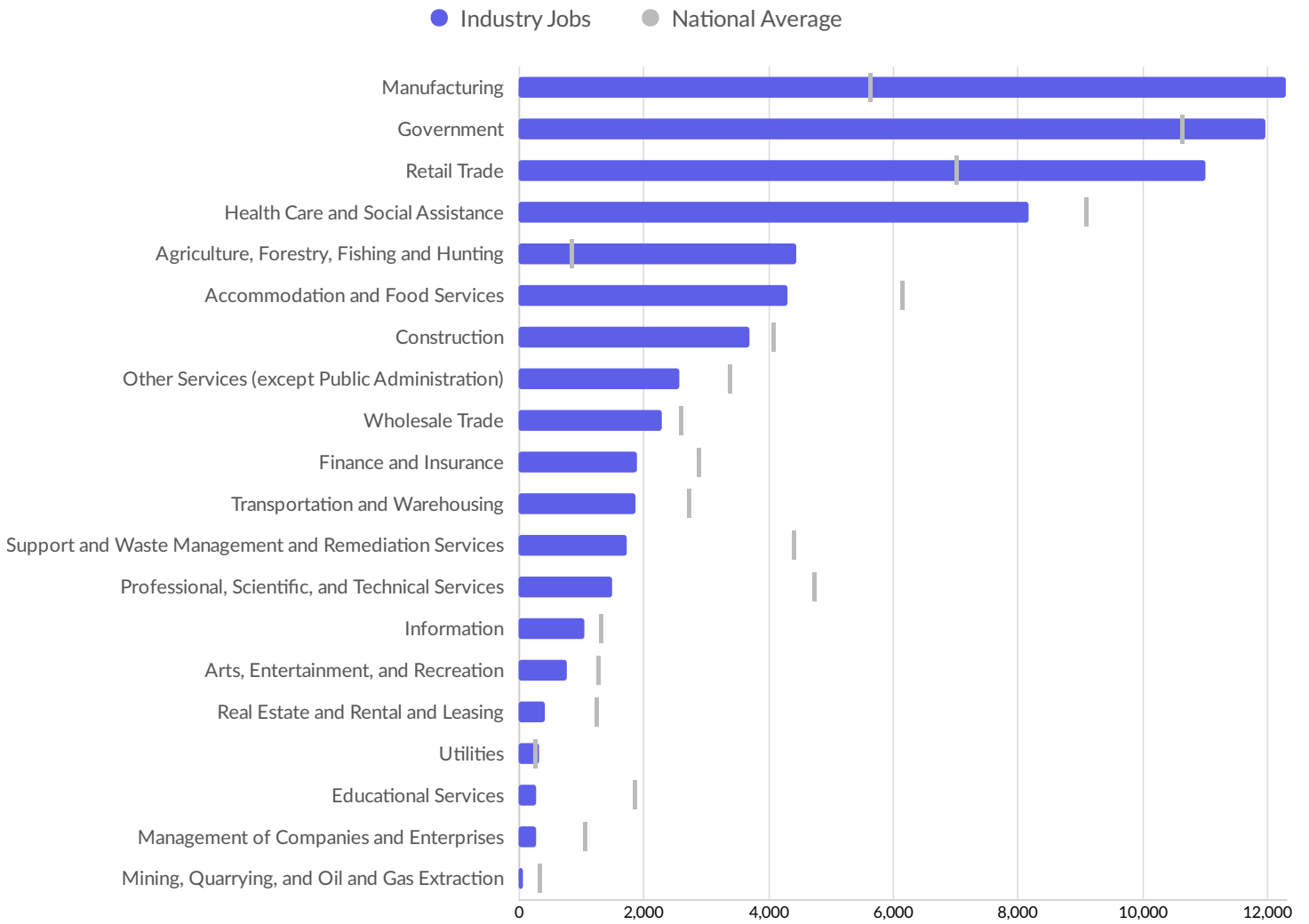

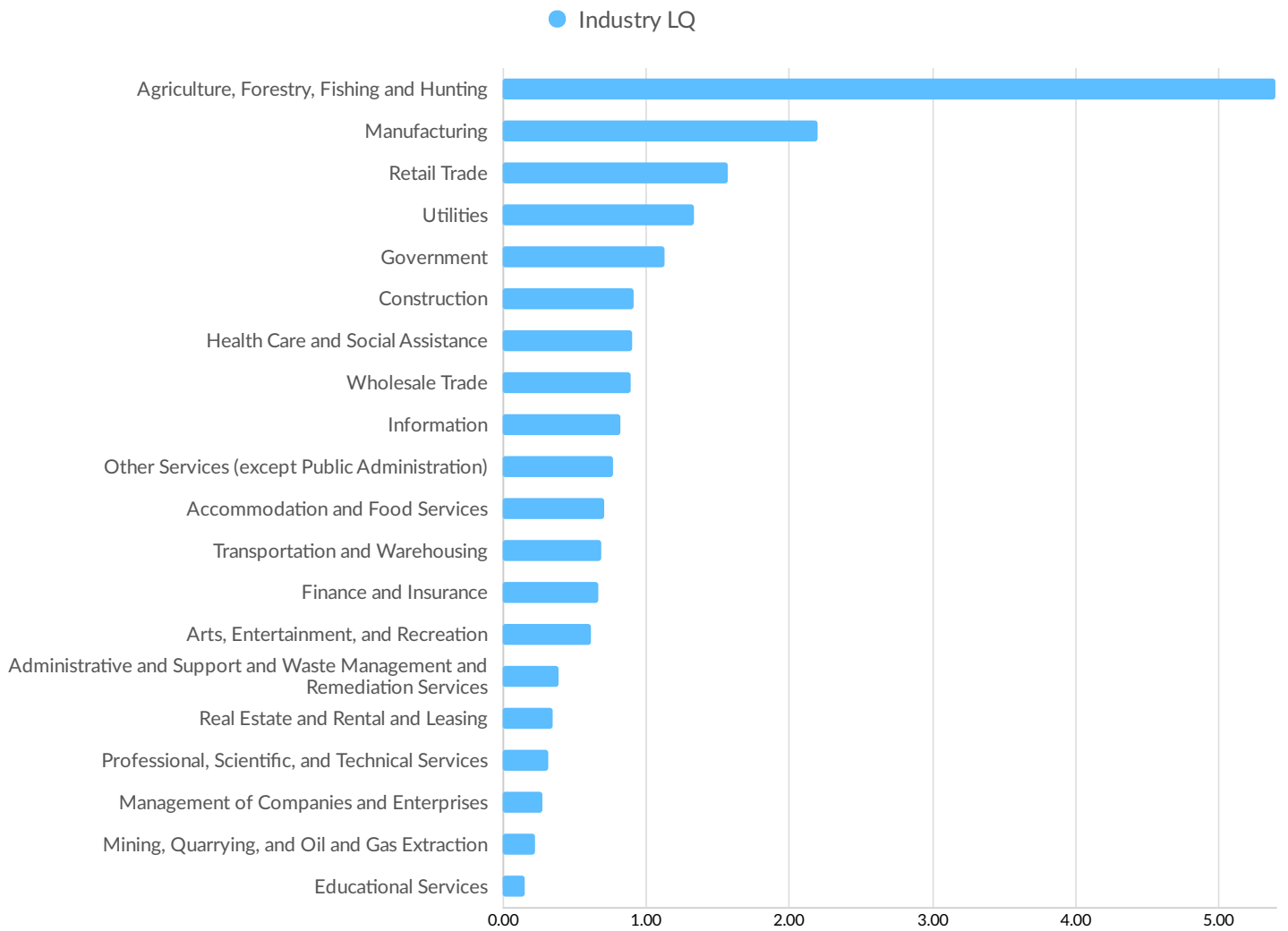

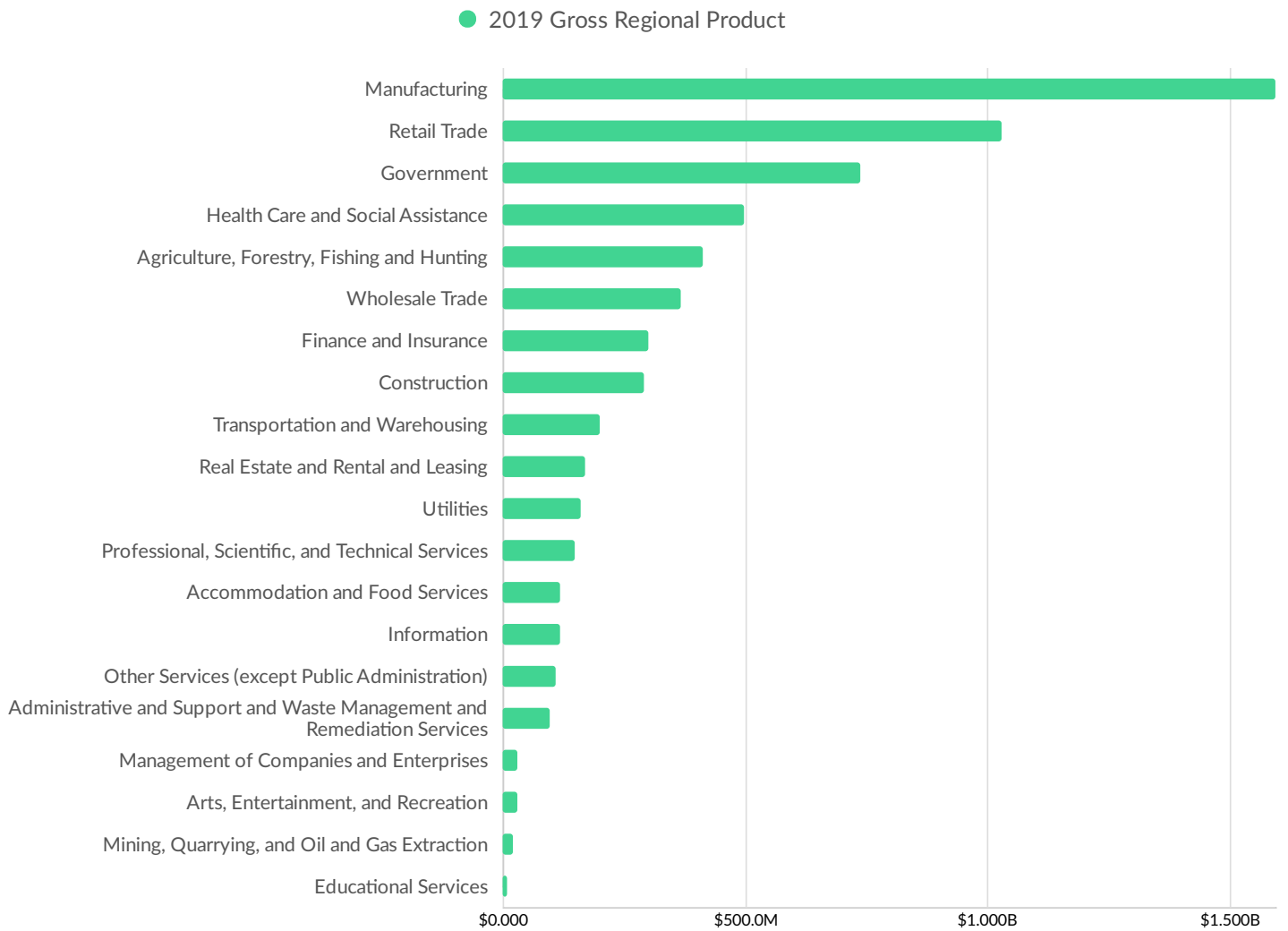

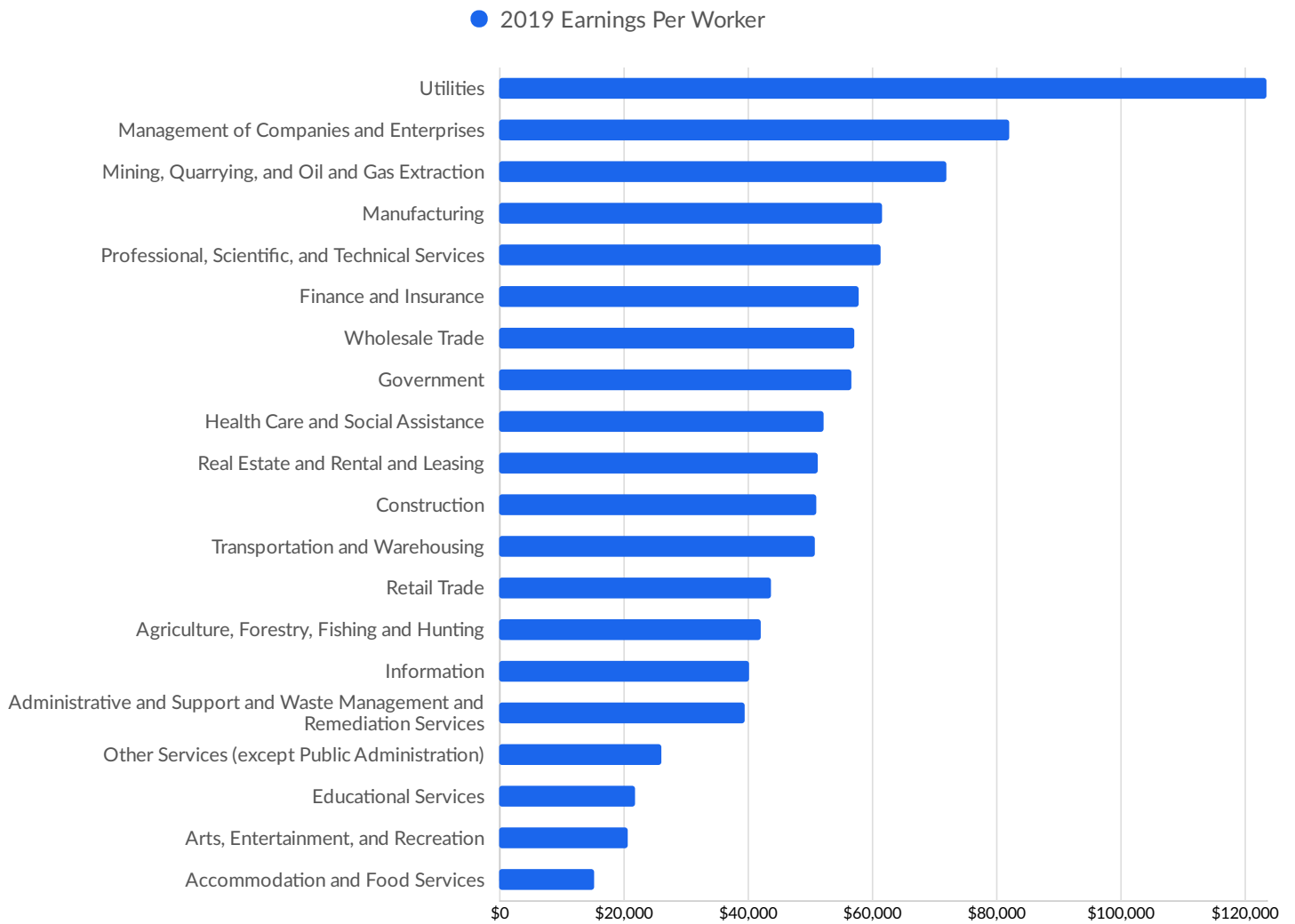

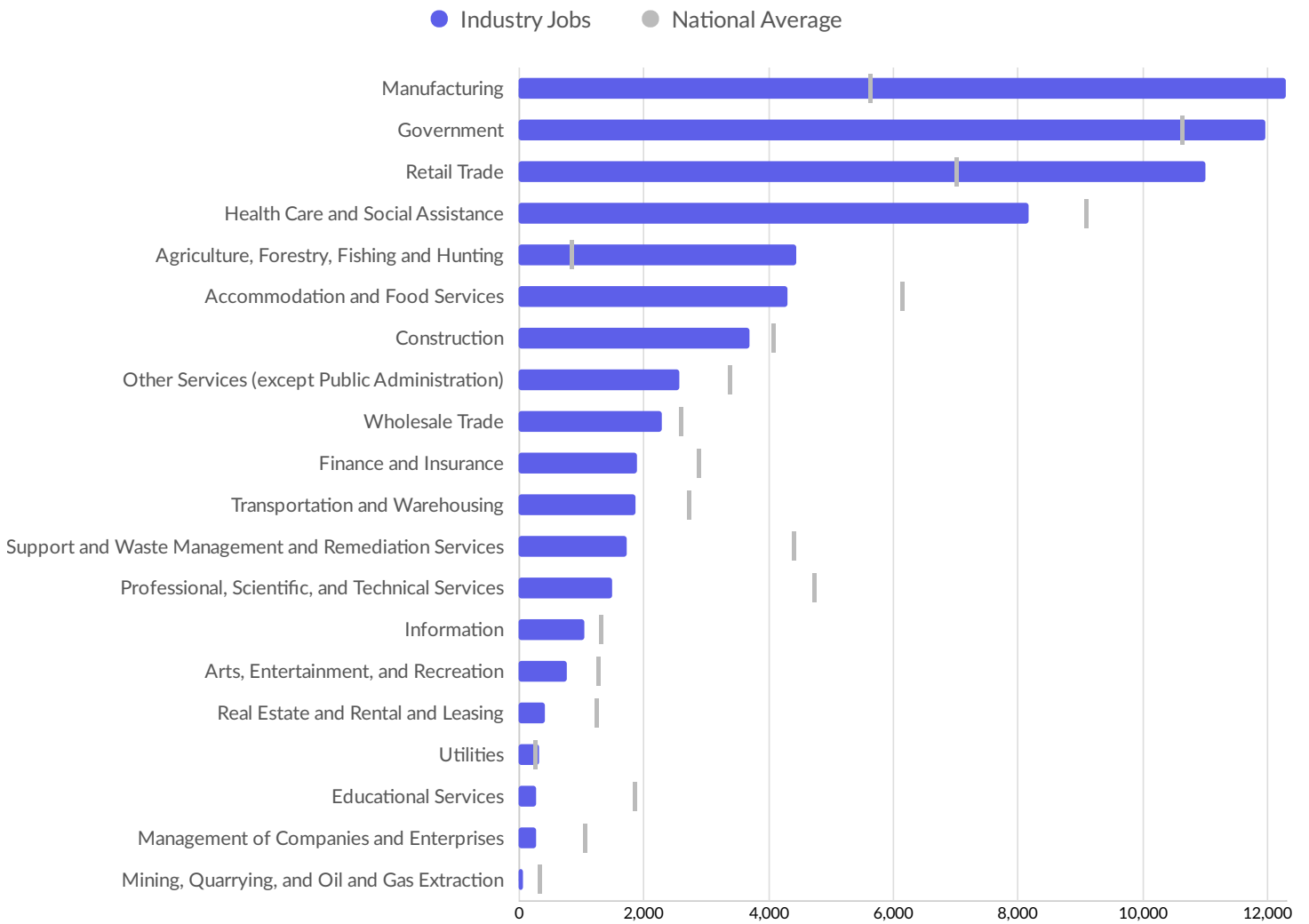

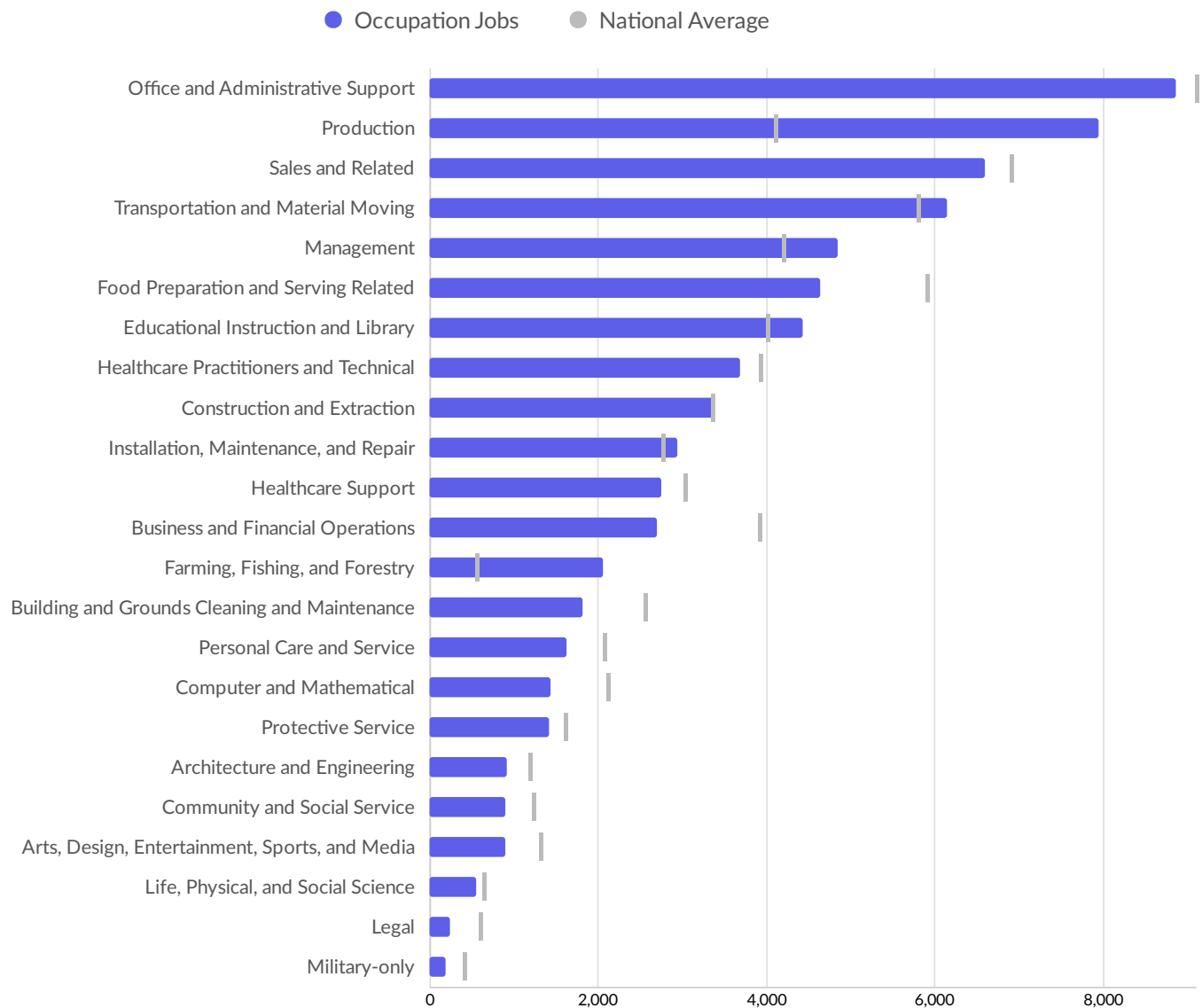

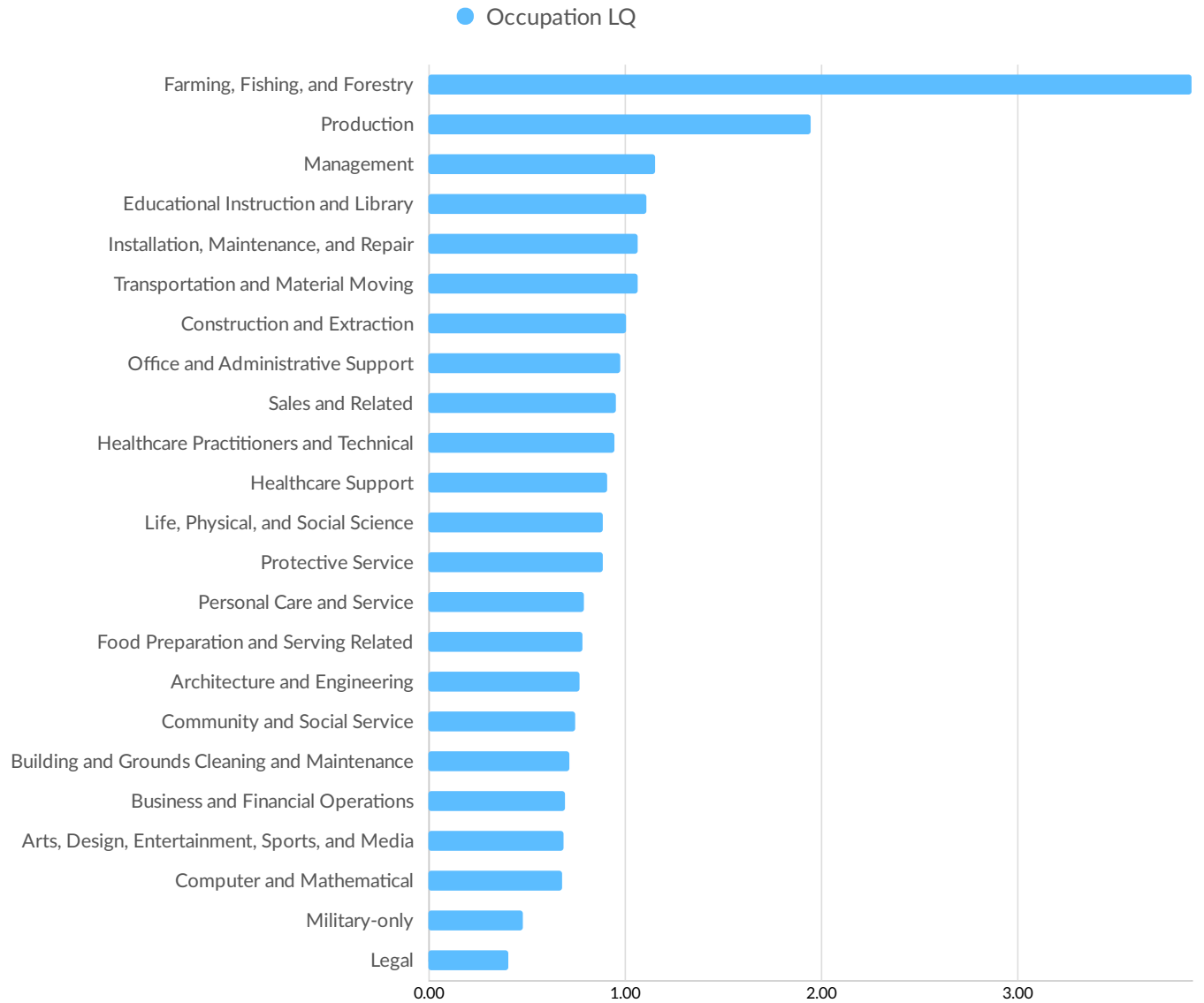

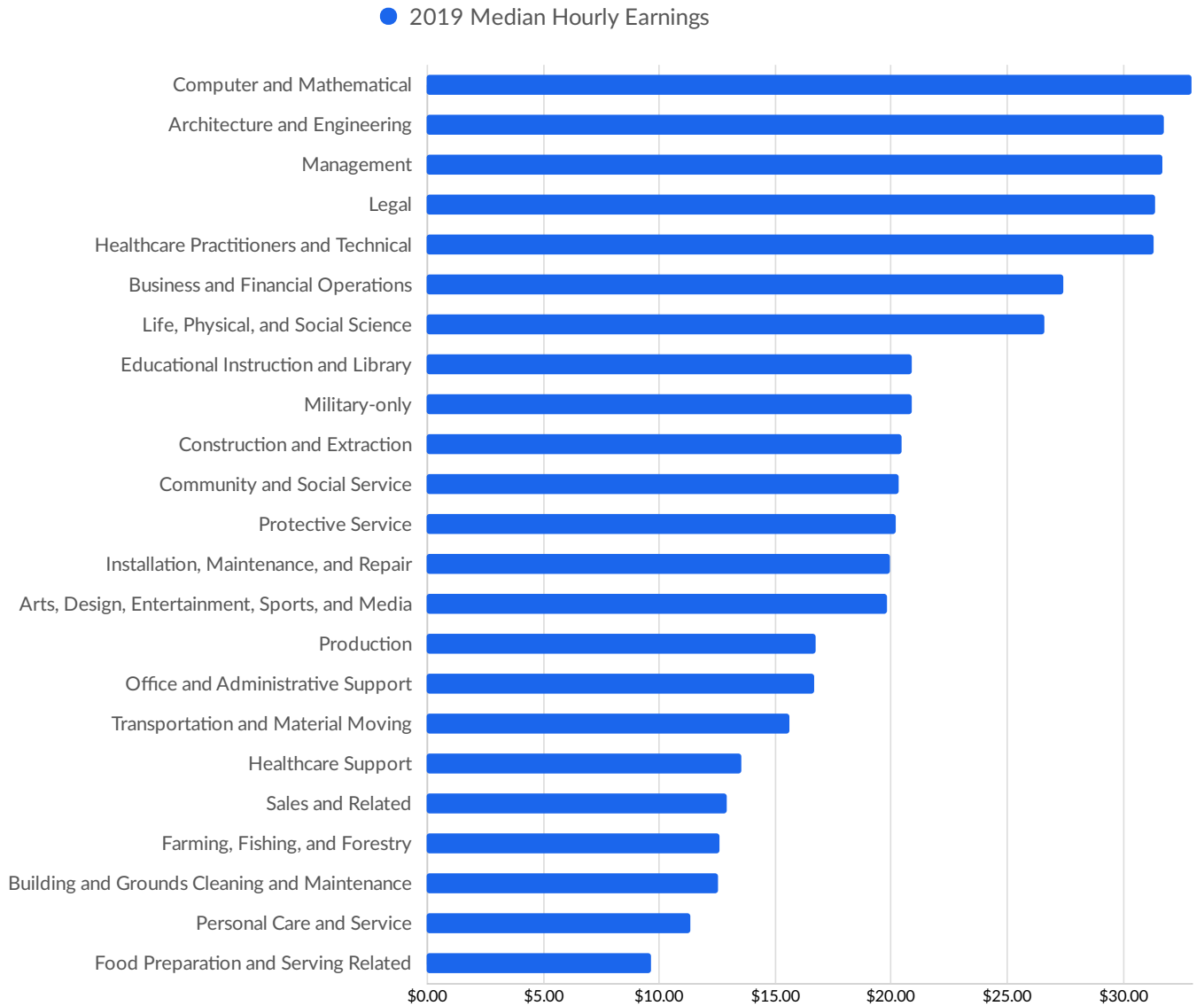
Top Growing Occupations



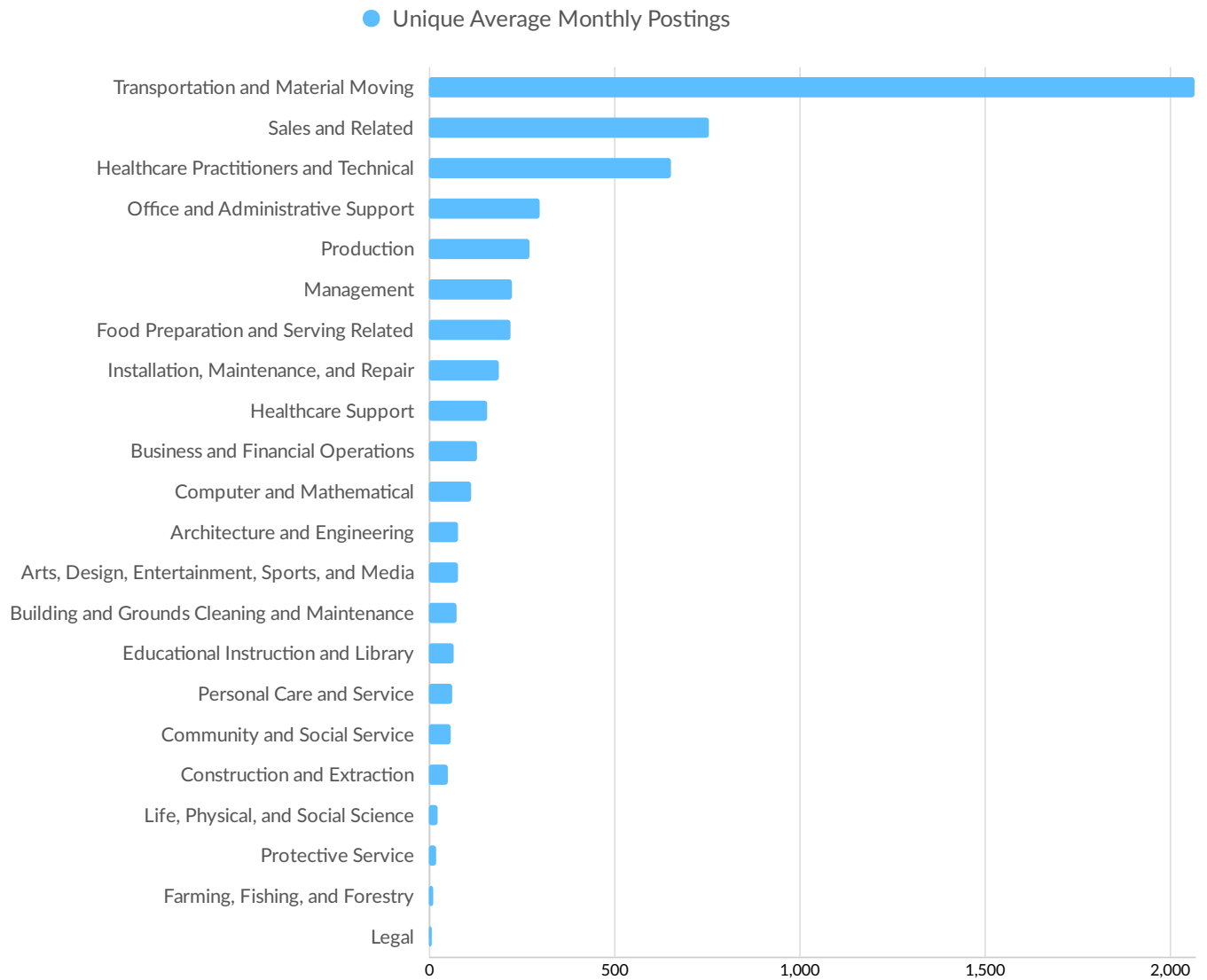

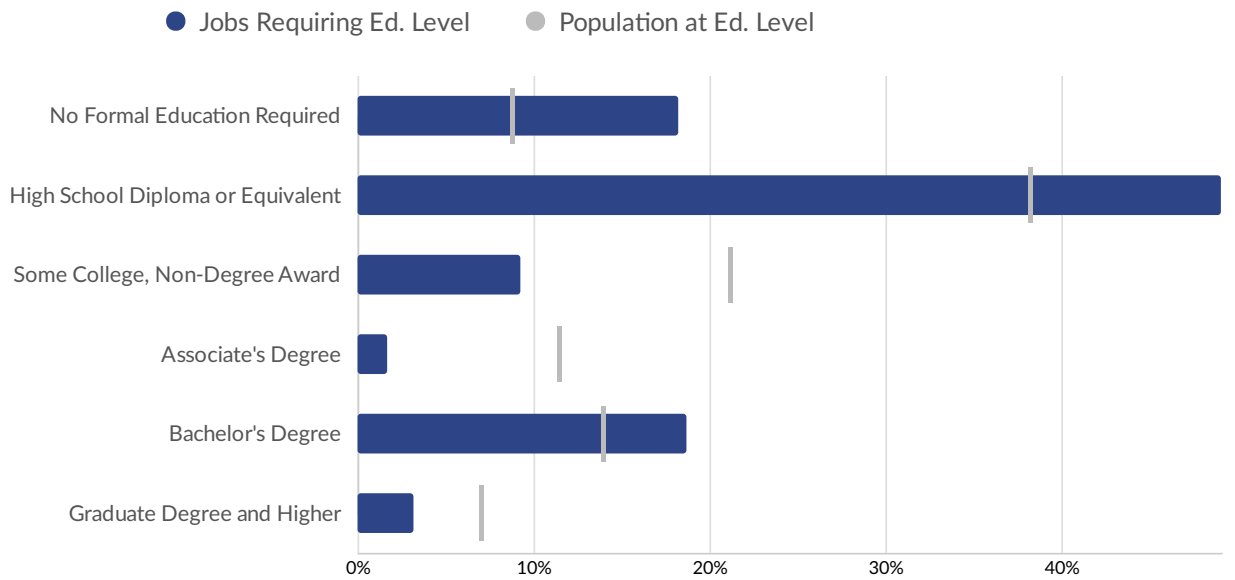

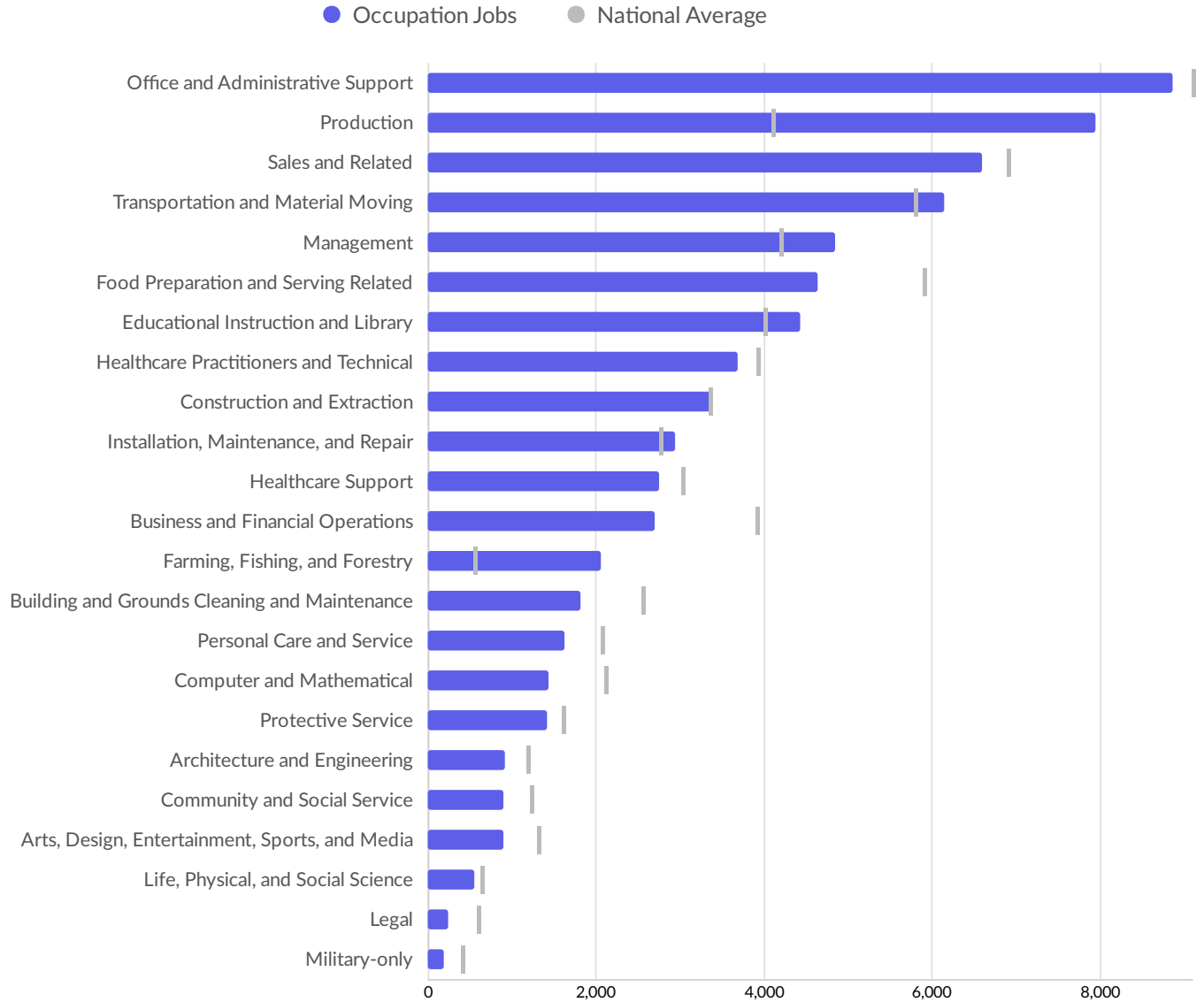

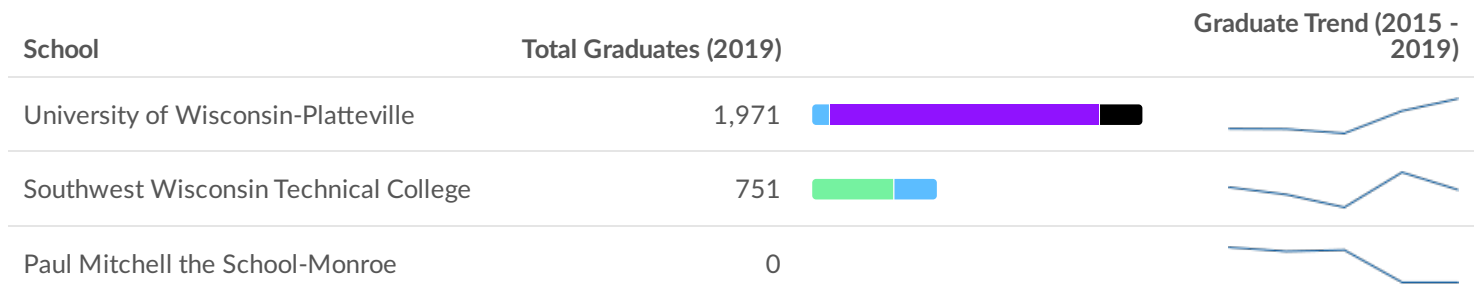
